Attention Mahanoy Township Authority Water Customers:

The Mahanoy Township Authority is notifying users that they are lifting the ban on non-essential water usage. There had been an activation of the Stage 1, Drought Contingency Plan for all customers issued on December 8, 2017. Stage 1 had prohibited all Non-Essential Water Uses in our service area. Effective today, the ban of non-essential water usage has been lifted. The following water uses are declared non-essential and are now permitted again in the service area: watering of lawns, outdoor gardens, landscaped areas, trees, shrubs, and other outdoor plants; washing of automobiles and trucks; washing of streets, driveways, and sidewalks; serving water in restaurants, clubs or eating places unless specifically requested by the individual; and ornamental water use.

We thank you for your cooperation during this time. We ask that you continue to utilize water responsibly as it is always precious commodity even in times of non-drought or emergency.
